#### Introduction to the course

Following this writing for publication course will enable you to improve your written academic discourse by increasing your awareness of organization, cohesion, advanced academic vocabulary and use of language. In this advanced course, you will work on your own completed draft, improving it step by step. By the end of the course, you will become aware of your language needs through analysis, practical tips, critical reading, peer review and discussion.
